UNOPPOSED MOTION ONE DAY EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE DEFENDANT'S POST-HEARING MEMORANDUM

filing his post-hearing supplemental memorandum be extended to 1 April 2013. A proposed

order is attached.

WHEREFORE, Jeffrey R. MacDonald respectfully requests that this Court extend

the time for filing of his post-hearing memorandum to 1 April 2013.
