SUBSTANTIATION:

On 15 Sep 72, Mr. Alfred KASSAB, Step-father of Colette MacDONALD, wrote a letter to the US Attorney. Raleigh, NC, and COMUSACIDC, stating that he had developed information that a girl, identified by this office as Miss LARSEN, had been seen kissing Jeffrey MacDONALD in the latter part of 1969, at the Patchogue Long Island, NY train station and at the time, Miss LARSEN was crying. Further, that Miss LARSEN is alleged to have moved from New York to California three days after the MacDONALD murders. Mr. KASSAB reported that Miss LARSEN fits the description of the female alleged to have been seen on a street corner a few blocks from the MacDONALD residence on the night of the murders as related by SP4 MICA during his Article 32 testimony.

CID Agent Audria L. METCALF, New York Field Office, First Region, USACIDC, Brooklyn, NY, prepared a written statement concerning his interview of Mr. and Mrs. Florence WHITBECK, East Patchogue, NY, whereas Mrs. WHITBECK stated that during the first week of September 1969 she took her daughter to the train station at Patchogue, NY at which time she observed Jeffrey MacDONALD and Miss LARSEN kissing at which time Miss LARSEN was crying. Mrs. WHITBECK related that she has known both MacDONALD and Miss LARSEN since their high school years.

CID Agent GROTTS prepared a written statement concerning the conduct of this investigation which revealed that Miss LARSEN was employed as an Executive Secretary at Clairol Inc., 345 Park Avenue, NY, during the period 13 March 1969 until 13 November 1970 and that she was present for work on both 16 and 17 February 1970. Further, that the records of flight manifests for Piedmont Airlines who serviced the Fayetteville, NC area in 1970 have since been destroyed thus precluding determining if Miss LARSEN traveled by air to the Fayetteville/Fort Bragg area on the dates in question. A check of motor vehicle records for the state of New York revealed that Miss LARSEN surrendered her New York Drivers License for a California State Drivers License on 11 Dec 70. CID Agent GROTTS further relates that based upon checks of other employment, neighborhood by postal records, and information related by KASSAB as having been developed by he and his wife from relatives and acquaintances; Miss LARSEN was reared in Medford Long Island, NY which is about two miles from Jeffrey MacDONALD's hometown of Patchogue, NY. Miss LARSEN dated Jeffrey MacDONALD regularly during his high school senior and college freshman years during an intermediate break in his pre-marriage relationship with Colette MacDONALD. From 1961 until 1969, Miss LARSEN was steadily employed first in Patchogue, Long Island and then in Plainview Long Island, NY during which time she listed her residence as the home of her father at 77 Oregon Ave., Medford Long Island, NY, which is within easy commuting distance of both towns. Later, while employed at Clairol Inc., she listed her address as 70

Susan URBANIAK, a long time friend of Colette MacDONALD told Mrs. Mildred KASSAB that Colette had once confided in her that she considered Miss LARSEN as her major rival and considered her the only possible threat to her marriage. Mrs. URBANIAK further related to Mrs. KASSAB another incident reported to her by Colette MacDONALD whereas, believed to have been at the MacDONALD apartment in Chicago, Ill, Colette discovered Jeffrey MacDONALD kissing another female while sitting on a couch and Colette kicked Jeffrey MacDONALD on the shins. Colette MacDONALD did not identify the female to URBANIAK. Ellie KWIATKOSKI, a friend of the KASSAB's and former acquaintance of Miss LARSEN, is the person from whom Mr. KASSAB received his information that Miss LARSEN departed New York for California three days after the murder. Mrs. KASSAB, in a subsequent conversation with

KWIATKOSKI determined that KWIATKOSKI did not have any factual information as to the exact date that Miss LARSEN moved to California; only that a former classmate attempting to notify Miss LARSEN of their class reunion, telephoned Miss LARSEN's mother and was allegedly advised that Miss LARSEN had moved to California and was not giving out her new address. KWIATKOSKI further advised Mrs. KASSAB that Miss LARSEN in the past, circulated information that either on the date of the marriage of Colette and Jeffrey MacDONALD, or the day before, Miss LARSEN was at her job at Sweezy & Newlin Department Store, Patchogue Long Island, NY when Jeffrey MacDONALD visited the store. Upon departing work for the day, Miss LARSEN found a note from Jeffrey MacDONALD in her car. KWIATKOSKI had no knowledge of the contents of the alleged note. Bonnie STEPHANSON, wife of Colette's brother, told Mr. KASSAB that she attended a birthday party for Jeffrey MacDONALD's mother at MacDONALD's mother's home at which time, Miss LARSEN was there, escorted by Jay MacDONALD. Colette pointed Miss LARSEN out to STEPHANSON as a former girlfriend of Jeffrey MacDONALD. During the party, Colette expressed some jealousy that MacDONALD's Mother allowed Miss LARSEN to open some of her gifts; as if she were including Miss LARSEN as a member of the family rather than Colette MacDONALD. Carol ANDERSON, Mrs. KASSAB's niece, told Mr. KASSAB that she also attended the birthday party but does not know or recall Miss LARSEN. She did relate, however, a rumor that the summer following Jeffrey MacDONALD's first year of marriage he was working for Building Ventures. Inc. at Montack Long Island, NY and had a brief affair with a Gloria Loyd, a divorced woman working for the same company.

CID Agent GROTTS further relates that coordination with COL KENNETH WEINSTEIN, Commanding Officer, Sixth Region, USACIDC, Presidio of San Francisco, CA, revealed that Miss LARSEN is presently living at her listed address and that a discreet inquiry revealed no known contact with Jeffrey MacDONALD while living at this address.

that manifest records for 1970 have already been destroyed. During 1970, Piedmont was the only airlines servicing Fayetteville, NC.

On 1 Nov 72, this office was in receipt of a cassette tape from Mr Alfred KASSAB which bears recorded telephone conversations between Mr and Mrs KASSAB and various friends. They were evaluated as follows:

20 Oct 72: Telephone conversation between Mrs Mildred KASSAB and Susan URBANIAK, a longtime friend of Colette MacDONALD. URBANIAK told Mrs KASSAB that in the past, Colette confided in her that she, Colette, considered Carole Mae LARSEN to be her only possible rival of any consequence. No specifics, just talked in general terms that she considered Carole a threat to her marriage. Colette further related to Susan URBANIAK that she, Colette, once caught her husband, Jeffrey MacDONALD, kissing another female while sitting on a couch and Colette then kicked J. MacDONALD in the shins. URBANIAK thought from recollection that this incident took place in the MacDONALD apartment when they lived in Chicago. Colette did not identify the female to URBANIAK.

20 Oct 72: Telephone conversation between Mildred KASSAB and Ellie KWIATKOSKI, a former classmate of Carole Mae LARSEN. KWIATKOSKI is the source that told Mr KASSAB that Carole Mae LARSEN moved to California about three days after the murders. On this tape, KWIATKOSKI clarifies that she does not know when LARSEN moved to California. Only that they were having a class reunion and one classmate called Carole's mother to get a point of contact and the mother told her that Carole had moved to California but would not give her address. KWIATKOSKI further advised Mrs KASSAB that LARSEN told her that on the day of the marriage of Jeffrey and Colette MacDONALD, or the day before, Carole was at her job at SWEEZY & NEWLIN Department Store in Patchogue Long Island, NY and that Jeffrey came in the store that day. When LARSEN quit work to go home she found a note from Jeffrey MacDONALD in her car. No further on contents of the note.

<u>21 Oct 72</u>: Telephone conversation between Mr KASSAB and Bonnie STEPHANSON, Colette's brother's wife: At a birthday party for Jeffrey MacDONALD's mother, Carole Mae LARSEN was present, escorted to the party by Jay MacDONALD, brother to Jeffrey MacDONALD. Colette pointed out Miss LARSEN to Bonnie as a former girlfriend of Jeffrey's and stated that she was relieved to see that Carole was not as attractive as before. Colette did express some jealousy that MacDONALD's mother allowed Miss LARSEN to open some of her gifts; as if she were including LARSEN in the family rather than Colette. Bonnie STEPHANSON further described Jeffrey MacDONALD's actions as "changed" in about the last year before the murders as he would not exhibit any friendly overtures toward STEPHANSON which should be natural due to their family ties.

21 Oct 72: Telephone conversation between Mr KASSAB and Carol ANDERSON, former friend of Colette. She does not know or recall Carole Mae LARSEN, although she did attend the birthday party described by STEPHANSON. She
