NOW COMES the Defendant, Jeffrey R. MacDonald, by and through undersigned counsel, and gives notice to the Court that he hereby waives his right to appointed counsel for the evidentiary hearing currently scheduled for April 30, 2012. Defendant's waiver results from the following:

- 1. Although MacDonald has established that he qualifies for court-appointed counsel pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §3006A, he recognizes that representation by counsel with considerable habeas experience is critically important at this stage in the proceedings.
- 2. Taking into consideration the factual and legal complexities of his case, MacDonald has concerns with the appointment recommendations made by the Federal Public Defender's Office concerns supported by the acknowledgement by the pending appointment that he has "limited post-conviction experience."
- 3. MacDonald's current counsel has been informed by the Federal Public Defender's Office that because the appointment of lead counsel in this case is being made for an evidentiary hearing in District Court, the list of attorneys with more extensive post-conviction appellate experience is not available for appointment to MacDonald.

4. The Government's counsel not only has extensive habeas experience, but has the benefit

of over forty years of experience with the facts of this particular case.

5. MacDonald's lead counsel will be significantly disadvantaged with regard to a complete

understanding of the record of this case and, therefore, will not have sufficient time to also

become proficient regarding the complexities of the successive habeas petitions.

6. For the foregoing reasons, and in an attempt to prevent being at a complete disadvantage

in his pursuit of justice, MacDonald finds he has no other option than to waive his right to

appointed counsel for the pending evidentiary hearing before the District Court.
