I am writing in regard to the letter you received from Margaret Thomas with the Fourth Circuit Court of Appeals, dated October 9, 2014. It should be noted that the Movant's pending Motion to Alter or Amend the Judgment, pursuant to Fed.R.Civ.P. 59(e), filed by attorneys Gordon Widenhouse and Keith Williams on August 21, 2014, applies only to Judge Fox's **July 24**, 2014, Order denying Movant's claims pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2255. However, the Notice of Appeal filed October 7, 2014, by attorney Christine Mumma, states that it applies only to Judge Fox's August 8, 2014, Order denying relief under the Innocence Protection Act ("IPA"), 18 U.S.C. § 3600.
