NOW COMES the Defendant, Jeffrey R. MacDonald, requesting additional time to reply to the government response in the above captioned case, dated October 27, 2015.

In support of this Motion, the Defendant provides the Court with the following:

- 1. Defendant received the Response on November 3, via the prison mail system.
- 2. Defendant awaited instructions from the Court, but has since learned that a Reply is optional, and therefore, no letter from the Court was in order.
- 3. The government Response is quite lengthy (approximately 29 pages) and a Reply (which Defendant would appreciate the opportunity to provide) will require research and the time needed to address the government's filing in a manner that is worthy of the Court's attention.
- 4. Defendant is limited in his ability to acquire needed information and documentation in order to reply, given reliance on U.S. first class mail and prison procedures which can delay the mailing and receipt of items. In addition, the preparation of a Reply document requires technical logistics which are not in the Defendant's control and will require time and a dependency on the availability of prison staff to complete.
- 5. The length of the government Response requires more time to address than would be needed by an attorney; the Defendant asks the Court for an extension of time as he is currently self-represented by necessity.

THEREFORE, the undersigned respectfully requests that this Motion be granted and that the Defendant be permitted 30 days to provide a Reply by December \_\_\_\_, 2015.
